

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 10723(b) of the California Water Code and Section 6066 of the California Government Code that beginning at 2:00 p.m. on March 8, 2017, a public hearing will be held by the Board of Directors (Board) of the joint powers authority named the Southwest Kings Groundwater Sustainability Agency (Agency) at Kettleman City Community Services District – 110 General Petroleum Avenue, Kettleman City, California 93239.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to hear comments from the public regarding the Agency's proposed formation of a Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) within its boundaries in the Tulare Lake Subbasin in Kings County.

After the public hearing, the Board may choose to adopt a Resolution of Intent to become a GSA and to submit notification to the California Department of Water Resources, which shall be posted pursuant to California Water Code Section 10733.3 and will include a description of the proposed boundaries of the portions of the Subbasin the Agency intends to manage pursuant to the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act.
